How to Comment on the PR Application

WHAT YOU NEED TO KNOW

Proposed extraction and production activities will:



Target helium and methane gas.



Drill up to 43 production wells.



Gas gathering pipelines.



A helium recovery and gas processing plant (CNG and/or LNG) and other related infrastructure.

In 2024, **Motuoane Energy (Pty) Ltd** (Motuoane/ the Applicant) was granted an **Exploration Right (ER)** by the Petroleum Agency South Africa (PASA) to look for gas fields in the Free State.

The Applicant is now applying to change a portion of their existing ER area (ER315) into a **Production Right (PR)**.

The proposed extraction and production activities will target helium and methane gas. They will include drilling up to 43 production wells, gas-gathering pipelines, a helium recovery and gas-processing plant (CNG and/or LNG), and other related infrastructure.*

Exploration vs Production

Exploration is activities undertaken, such as conducting seismic surveys and drilling test wells, to discover if there are minerals and petroleum, including oil and gas.

Once these places have been identified, **Production** is the process of extracting petroleum resources (like oil, gas and condensate) from the earth and ocean floor. If a PR is granted, it gives a company the right to remove oil or gas over longer periods of time.

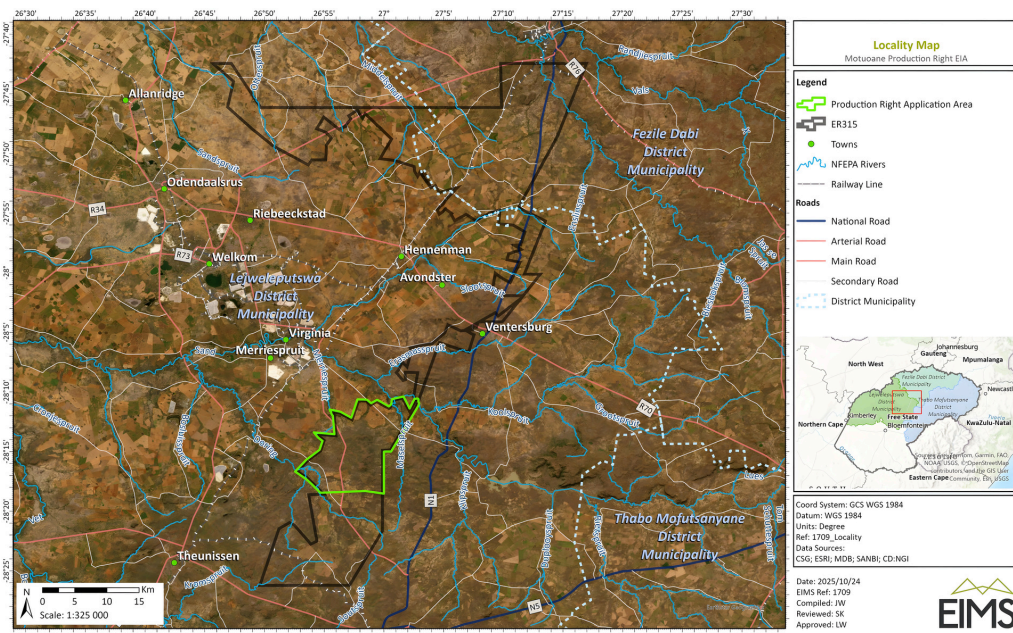



Figure 1: Locality Map, Motouane PR Area. Affected communities include Virginia/ Meloding; Theunissen/ Makeleketla; and Venterburg/ Mmamahabane. Source: <https://www.eims.co.za/wp-content/uploads/2025/Public/1709/SR/AppA.pdf>

Motouane has applied for a **Production Right**. The law requires an Environmental Impact Assessment (EIA) to be done. This process assesses the possible positive and negative impacts of the proposed project. The Environmental Impact Assessment (EAP) appointed to conduct this assessment is *EIMS*, which will undertake the required processes, including public participation, compiling reports, and providing support for the proposed project.

The process is currently at the beginning of the EIA process, the Scoping Phase. A [Background Information Document \(BID\)](#) with an overview of the application has been published to inform the public. Interested and Affected Parties (I&AP), such as local communities, are invited to register to submit comments on the project.

 *This current EIA process is specifically to assess the impacts of the proposed production activities. At this stage, no in-person meetings are planned. Communities and other affected parties can participate by writing and submitting comments.*
